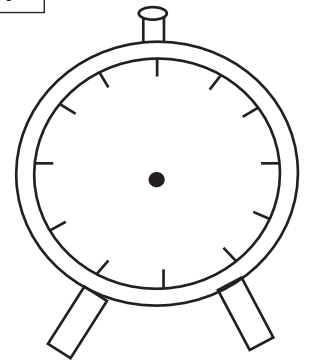

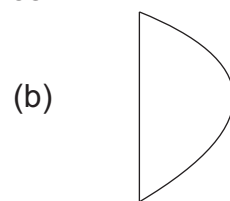
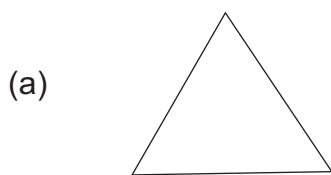

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Introduction:

Communication means sharing of information. It's the process of exchanging thoughts and feelings with people. It enables us to know each other. There are a number of ways by which communication can take place. We can communicate through:

Gestures, Expressions, speaking, writing, sounds, signals, speech, printing and photograph.

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Means of communication:

We communicate with others through different means of communication. In earlier times, people used sounds and signs to communicate. Today, we can communicate with others by writing letters and by speaking on the telephone or mobile phone. We can also send messages through mobile phones or send e-mails through the Internet. All these methods of sending and receiving messages are known as means of communication.

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Types of communication:

Broadly, means of communication are of two kinds:

(I) One-to-one communication:

It means we can communicate with one person at a time. It includes Postal communication and Telephonic communication.

(ii) Mass communication:

It means we can communicate with many people at a time. It includes newspapers, radio, computer, television, mobile phones and fax machine.

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Postal communication:

- 1- The postal system helps us to send and receive letters.
- 2- We can buy stamps, post cards and inland letters from the post office.
- 3- We should write the address of the person to whom we are sending the letter clearly on the envelope.
- 4- We should write PIN code (Postal Index Number) along with the address.
- 5- We should also write our own address on the back of the envelope.
- 6- The stamp that we should use depends on the place where we have to send the letter and the weight of that letter.
- 7- We should put the letter in letter box or give it at the post office for delivery.

Telephonic communication:

- 1- Through a telephone, we can talk to anyone living in any part of the world immediately
- 2- Usually, telephone calls within our city cost less while calls to other parts of the country or the world cost more.
- 3- Those who do not own a phone can use the phones of a PCO (Public Call Office) by paying a small amount of money.

Mass Communication:

- 1- There are many ways through which we can send message to many people at once at the same time. This is known as mass communication.
- 2- The different means of mass communication are- news papers, radio, television and the Internet. They are also known as mass media.
- 3- A newspaper is a printed set of paper sheets that contains news and information about some important events happening in the world. Newspaper are printed in different languages.
- 4- A radio is an instrument that people use to listen news and important information. We can also listen songs and other programmes on the radio.

A television gives us information through sound and moving pictures. It is an effective means of mass communication.

People use computers to communicate with each other. Messages or pictures can be sent through e-mails from one computer to another through the Internet. People can also see and talk to each other through video conferencing through the Internet.

People use mobile phones to talk to people or to send then text messages through SMS (Short Message Service).

A fax machine helps us to send copies of documents through a telephone line or by e-fax. We can only send documents by fax to someone who also has a fax machine.

Conclusion:

- 1- The means of communication have become faster and better over the years.
- 2- We choose our means of communication based on our needs. Whatever means of communication we use, we should always be polite to people.
- 3- We should always try to speak the truth and not hurt anyone with our speech.
